The Dillsboro Public Library has been selected to host a traveling Smithsonian exhibit, Crossroads: Change in Rural America, which highlights the changing landscape in rural America. Since 1900, the percentage of Americans living in rural areas dropped from 60 percent to 17 percent, yet the vast majority of America's physical landscape remains rural. "Crossroads" looks at this remarkable societal change and how rural Americans responded. The photographs are invited to explore the past, present and future of Dillsboro.

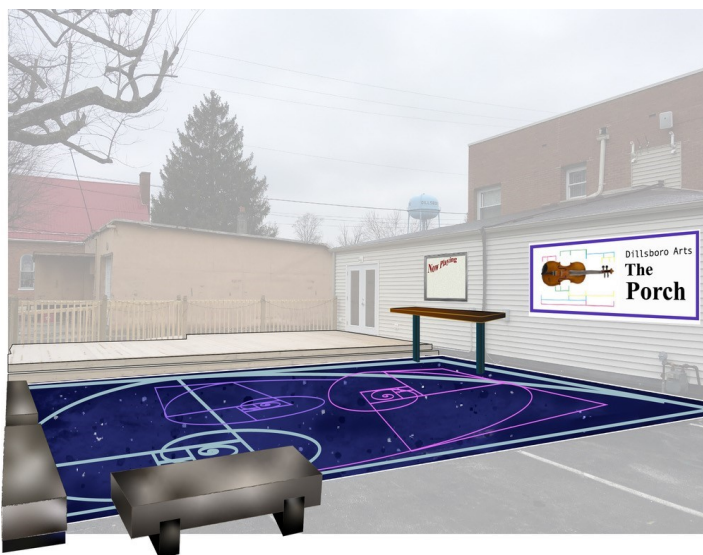
Entries will be on display at the Dillsboro Public Library after judging. A reception will be held on Saturday, September 7, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.

Dillsboro Awarded Quick Impact Place-based Grant

Lt. Governor Suzanne Crouch and the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs have announced the award for quality of place initiative. Dillsboro is one of 11 communities selected from 49 throughout the State of Indiana. Funding will transform an asphalt space in the downtown to be used as a cultural, educational and community gathering place. Murals and a dance floor will be painted by local artists, with a few pieces of outdoor furniture crafted by community artisans. Project partners will include, Dillsboro Arts, Dillsboro Elementary Art teacher and Math Club sponsors, art students, Math Club members, Dillsboro Girl Scout Troop and community volunteers. Project Supporters will include, South Dearborn Community School Corporation, Dillsboro Community Partnership and Beautification of Dillsboro.

Frog Jumping Contest

OFFICIAL RULES:

1. All frogs must be transported to and from the contest in "frog-tainers" designed to protect the spectators from the critters.
2. All critters must be pure frog. No frog/rabbit or frog/dog combos!
3. The distance of the frog's jump will be determined by drawing a straight line from the starting circle to the point under the tip of the critter's nose, after it has completed 3 hops.
4. The frog must be completely in the starting circle for the 1st hop.
5. The "Frog Jockey" can touch the critter while in the starting circle but once the frog leaves the circle, it can't be touched.
6. PRIZES FOR THE JUMPING CONTEST: 1st Place-\$25 & Trophy; 2nd Place-\$15; 3rd Place-\$10; 4th Place-\$5 and 5th Place-\$5 SHORTEST JUMPER will win \$10
7. A BEST DRESSED FROG CONTEST will be held before the jumping contest. PRIZES FOR THE BEST DRESSED FROGS in their "Jumpsuits": 1st Place-\$25 & Trophy; 2nd Place-\$15; 3rd Place-\$10; 4th Place-\$5 and 5th Place-\$5. This years festival theme is "The Sounds of Summer". Best Dressed Frog Contestants are encouraged (but not required) to dress their frog in an outfit pertaining to the festival theme.
8. Registrations for both frog jumping and the best dressed contests will start at 5:00pm and will end at 6:15pm. Participants in the frog jumping contest will jump in the order of their registration and will be given a jumping number. Participants will line up by their number to enter the FROG ARENA. Failure to promptly report to line up to enter the FROG ARENA may result in disqualification.
9. All decisions of the judges and/or Frog Jumping Commissioner shall be final and they reservet he right to change the rules as necessary!
